

Oiler Attack Player Contract

_____ (Player) desires to participate in the Junior Olympic Volleyball Program administered by Oiler Attack Club.

_____ (Parent) is the parent/guardian of Player and gives permission for Player to participate in the activities of Oiler Attack Club.

In exchange for Oiler Attack Club's agreement to permit Player to participate in the OAC Program:

Parent and Player Agree to:

1. Pay all OAC fees in a timely manner, and pay all monies due to OAC by the deadline posted for your team.
2. Become familiar with and adhere to all OAC eligibility guidelines;
3. Become familiar with and adhere to all OHSAA eligibility guidelines;
4. Become and remain familiar and adhere to all OAC and team rules and regulations pertaining to both parents and players;
5. Exhibit a commitment to OAC through practice and tournament attendance.

Player and Parent understand and acknowledge that volleyball is a vigorous and potentially dangerous activity and that participation in practices and matches poses a risk to the Player's well-being. Parent and Player, nonetheless, desire Player's participation and release and hold harmless OAC and its officers and coaches from any liability in the event of injury to Player.

Player and Parent understand that failure to pay OAC fees in the time designated by OAC may result in Player being suspended from full participation in the team or may result in suspension or dismissal from OAC. Player and Parent acknowledge the OAC officers and/or coaches are the final arbiters of whether Player and Parent have complied with OAC and/or team rules and regulations.

Player and Parent understand and agree that a refund or return of fees or other monies paid by Player and Parent to OAC will only be given in the event of Player injury and in those circumstances will be dealt with based on the format laid out in the OAC Manual. Refunds or return of fees will not be given for any other reason. This includes but is not limited to:

1. Player's suspension or dismissal from the OAC program;
2. Player's decision to discontinue their participation in the OAC program;

Player and Parent understand and agree that there is no guarantee in the amount of playing time player receives in exchange for fees and other monies paid by Player or Parent.

Player and Parents must remain in good standing with the OAC for the duration of the season. Players maybe removed from teams for breaking any rule in the OAC guidelines including *unsportsmanlike conduct by Player or Parents*. Players that are dismissed from OAC for any reason are not entitled to any portion of their payments back.
